Damaged sheet flooring can be repaired quickly and easily by following the steps outlined below:

- 1. Cut around the damaged area in a neat circle or square.
- 2. Remove the damaged section of flooring.
- 3. Scrape any old adhesive of the subfloor.
- 4. Repair any damage to the subfloor.
- 5. Cut a piece of matching flooring to suit.
- 6. Glue the piece in place using a suitable adhesive.
- 7. Finish by welding the joins with a matching weld rod.
